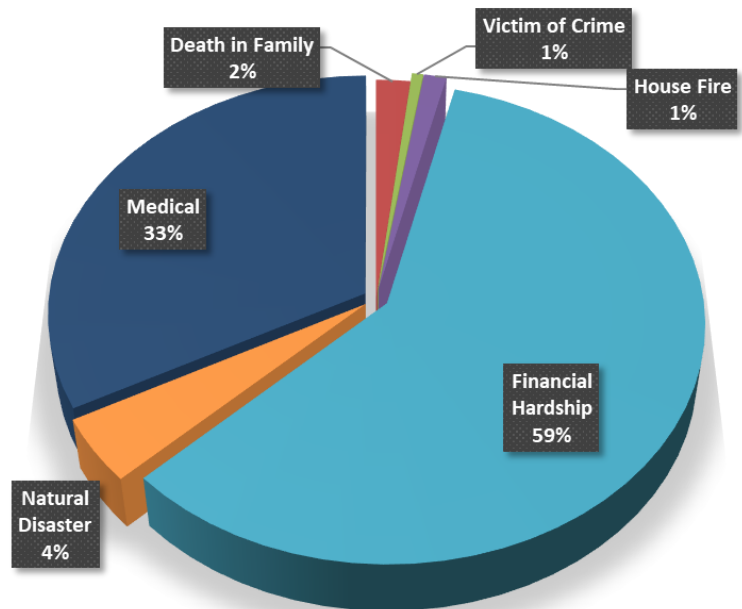
Report for calendar year 2019

History

Founded in 2009, the fund is supported primarily by McCoy's employees' charitable donations which are made using an automatic payroll deduction as well as private donations, proceeds from fund raising events, and awards from philanthropic organizations.

As of 12/31/2019, the fund provided **\$1,175,754** in assistance to 1135 McCoy's Building Supply team members and their families.
